1. Puna Snipe Sauvignon Blanc Chile

Fresh, crisp and dry with fresh grass, gooseberry and passion fruit on the palate. Good minerality leads to a long finish. Great with salads, fish and chicken dishes.

2. Bay Tree Chardonnay Languedoc, France

The Bay Tree's very own wine from a fantastic winery in the South of France. A fruity nose and medium-bodied on the palate with a long elegant and minerally finish. Perfect with white meats, grilled fishes, and salads or simply as an aperitif.

3. Il Papavero Pinot Grigio Sicily

This gem comes from a small site in the Sicilian Hills where the cooler air helps to balance the ripe grapes, resulting in a mouth-watering mix of pear and citrus fruit. Perfect for light lunchtime drinking or in the evening with fish.

4. Greenstone Point Sauvignon Blanc New Zealand

Displays ripe tropical fruit aromas with hints of capsicum and gooseberry. Soft and rounded with a long finish. A lovely wine! Fantastic with goats cheese.

5. Croix des Vents Syrah Rose France

Deep, rich and bright colour. Luxurious, intense bouquet with strawberries and raspberries. Fresh, delicate mouth is well balanced with lovely freshness.

6. Puna Snipe Merlot Chile

Beautiful violet-purple colour, characterised by its fruitiness and rich varietal aromas. Medium bodied with soft notes of violets, plum and berries on palate; vanilla and mocha appear on long finish.

7. The Bay Tree Cabernet Sauvignon Languedoc, France

The Bay Tree's own red. Deep red in colour. Nose shows a lot of fruit, blackberries with spicy notes. The structure is intense but soft, Good with any kind of meat especially game and with good cheeses.

8. Aso & Gordon Tempranillo Spain

Made by Irishman Dermot Gordon and his Spanish wife Mercedes, This 100% Tempranillo wine is complex in both flavour and structure. It is full of intense red fruit flavours and is beautifully smooth and easy to drink.

9. Stonefish Shiraz Australia

Rich, ripe palate with red berries interwoven with subtle, spicy oak. Medium bodied wine enhanced by soft tannins. Great with red meats and more robust dishes.

10. Il Prosecco Frizzante Conti Neri Italy

This is a light, refreshing Prosecco that has a little touch of creaminess adding to the overall elegance of the wine. Fantastic way to start your meal.

11. Coldigiano Prosecco Brut Spumante Italy

A Spumante out of the top drawer. Fresh, crisp palate with tremendously well balanced citric fruit leading to lingering finish. Perfect as aperitif or accompaniment to seafood and white meat.

This special wine comes from the Ribera del Duero region of northern Spain, south west of its more famous cousin, Rioja. The region, situated along the river Duero, produces some of the best wines in Spain; it is the home of the wine of the Spanish King. The bodega owner, Pepe, only produces this special selection artisan wine in small quantities and it is exclusive to The Bay Tree.
